



What is Kids Club?

Kids Club is an after-school group program for children who have experienced domestic and family violence.

Who is it for?

Kids Club is for children aged 8 to 12 years old.

When is Kids Club held?

Kids Club runs for 8 weeks during each school term for 1.5 hours on a Thursday afternoon.

The sessions run from 3:30 to 5:00pm.

What does it involve?

Attendance is free. Afternoon tea is provided.

At Kids Club, children have the opportunity to talk about their feelings while taking part in fun activities. Kids Club is a great way to meet new friends and identify safety networks.





Throughout the program, children build self-esteem and learn more about themselves by becoming aware of their strengths and skills.

This program is a step towards reducing further harm to children and reducing the likelihood of domestic and family violence trauma being carried into adolescence and adulthood.
